Kusuma Shalini fellow wins apprenticeship

Sunita Bukarwal was accepted into the Kusuma Udayan Shalini Fellowship Programme in Dehradun, Uttarakhand in 2008. Her father is a farmer and, despite coming from an economically-challenged family, she is a bright student who scored 77% in the Higher Secondary Certificate examinations, including distinctions in four subjects.



Sunita recently took the final year examination for her Bachelor of Sciences degree. Through a campus interview, she was selected for the post of Officer in the Associated Cement Companies Ltd, and is currently undertaking her apprenticeship in a technical branch of the Ordnance Factory Department in Dehradun.

Sunita shares how the Shalini Fellowship has benefitted her and how her 'role model' status is impacting her peers: *"When I finished high school, I was the only girl in my village who selected science and maths as a study stream. It was difficult finding a tutor nearby and I had to cycle far from home to receive tuition. Today, in my village, many girls have opted for science and maths and consider me as an example. My parents feel very proud of me."*

EDUCATION

Kusuma Ratna Fellowship Programme

145 students and 12 mentors attended the annual mentoring meeting in June. A career counselling workshop for 45 Cohort One students and their parents took place, with a focus on academic objectives, career planning and the benefits of motivational workshops. The partner conducted and collected performance reports from 52 students from Cohort Two. A formal launch of the programme, to source applicants for Cohort Three, took place on 27 June. Posters, leaflets and applications forms were made ready for distribution to 204 schools in the district.

Kusuma Udayan Shalini Fellowship

Workshops on self-assessment and motivation took place in June. 50 students attended the first workshop on 5 June and another 50 students attended the second workshop on 19 June. An additional workshop, focused on the college admission process and college orientation, took place for Cohort Two students. Udayan Care liaised with the Institute of Chartered Accountants to explore course opportunities for the students. The partner also visited government offices to collect information on State-funded professional courses for minority groups.

Kusuma Young Achievers' Award

11 out of the 20 students who took the Class 12 supplementary examination passed, due to the counseling support from Pragathi Seva Samithi. 89% of the 46 students who took the Teacher Training Course Examination passed, enabling them to study tertiary teaching courses.

Mobile Science Laboratory (MSL)

The Trust signed a new one-year grant agreement on 1 July, committing £48,087 to support mobile science labs in 40 government schools in Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh.

Bridge School Programmes: Udaan & Pehchan

74 Udaan girls took examinations in spring. 26% of these girls received an A grade, 42% received a B grade, 26% a C grade and the remaining 6% passed. Of the 51 Pehchan girls who took examinations at the same time, 24% received an A or A+ grade, 33% girls received a B grade, 29% a C grade and the remaining 14% passed. The renovation of the classrooms will be completed by the end of August. The Trust is discussing a grant renewal proposal to support Udaan for one more year and Pehchan for an additional two years.

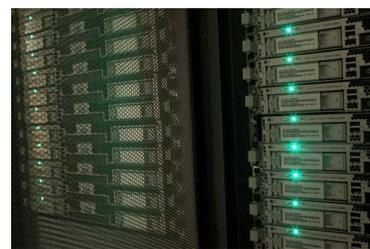
Project Saarathi

The Trust signed a new grant agreement on 1 July for £88,988, to roll out Saarathi training for 1,500 frontline workers in 10 cities in Andhra Pradesh. 30 candidates were selected for the Training of the Trainers programme, which starts on 25 July. It will be run by the Tata Institute of Social Sciences.
